Animal Care Services Officer

The County of Yuba is currently recruiting for one (1) Animal Care Services Officer position within the Sheriff's Department. Under close supervision, the incumbent enforces State and County laws regarding stray, dangerous, rabid, nuisance and unwanted domestic animals; investigates complaints; patrols assigned areas; captures animals; performs other duties related to humane animal protection and control; performs related work as assigned including assisting the public with drop off, pick up and adoption of animals as necessary. This is a working level class in animal control, responsible for enforcing applicable regulations in a limited public officer capacity. Successful performance of the work requires skill in dealing with the public in difficult situations as well as a willingness to handle animals that may be injured or ill.

Ideal Candidate:

The ideal candidate must have a willingness to handle aggressive, injured and dead animals in potentially hazardous situations, be available to work extended or off-hours shifts, and may be called back in emergency situations. The incumbent must have a teamwork mentality but posses the ability to work independently when assigned.

Required Qualifications & Requirements:

<u>Minimum</u>: Equivalent to graduation from high school, one (1) year of experience in animal care or similar work which will have provided the required knowledge and skills.

Licensing & Certification Requirement:

Possession of or the ability to obtain within one (1) year of hire date, a California PC832 Peace Officer Certification.

<u>Preferred</u>: In addition to the above minimum, up to three (3) years of experience in animal care or similar work which will have provided the required knowledge and skills.

<u>Working Conditions</u>: Work evenings, nights, weekends, holiday extended hours, and rotating shifts. Working in an environment where the handling of aggressive, injured, ill and dead animals in potential hazardous situations occur.

Animal Care Services is a division of the Sherriff's Department. Animal Care Services provides services for the unincorporated areas of Yuba County and is located in Olivehurst, California. Animal Care Services care for lost animals, injured and abandon animals, and a provide variety of services that protect both citizens and animals.
