### A. Announcements / Upcoming Events

#### 1. Lions, Tigers, and PASS TIMES! Oh, My!

- **REMINDER: Pass 1 Appointment times begin Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>!**
- **Quick Tips to remember during your Pass time:**
  - You may register for no more than 17 units Pass 1, and you cannot waitlist for any courses until Pass 2.
  - Your pass time is four hours long. If you miss your Pass 1 or need to make adjustments, you may do so during Open Hours, which are from 8:00pm until midnight beginning the evening after your first appointment, or from 10am-6pm on weekends.
  - You must be registered (not waitlisted) in at least 12 units to have Full Time status, and to receive your full financial aid package.
  - You can build schedules and view courses in preparation for your pass time via Schedule Builder!
  - **If you run into problems, please contact us so we can help!** But also understand that we cannot always perform miracles, so it's important to be flexible and stay positive! 😊

#### 2. Nutrition Requirements for Vet School

- A nutrition course is NOT required for all vet schools. There are only certain vet schools which require nutrition; these vet schools are listed below:
  - Tuskegee University
  - Auburn University
  - University of Florida
  - Michigan State
  - North Carolina State
  - Oklahoma State
  - Purdue University
  - Texas A & M

- For the vet schools that do require Nutrition, courses NUT 115, NUT 123 and/or NUT 123L, or NUT 122 will count. Please check with the individual vet schools you plan to applying to for specific requirements.

### 3. NPB 121 and 121L: Registration Information

- Lecture Section A01 (which has 107 seats) is Pass 1 restricted to Animal Science Majors! Section A02 (100 seats) is NOT Pass 1 restricted.
- All NPB 121L lab sections are restricted to our majors, and a few others.
