Important Announcement: The Registration Freeze is Coming!

- The Registration Freeze begins on **December 15th, 2014!** Be sure to pay your student fees by this deadline.
- In order to receive your financial aid, you **MUST** be registered in at least 12 units by the Registration Freeze! Wait-listed units *DO NOT COUNT* toward the 12 unit minimum for Full Time status.
- If you are not registered in 12 units by the end of Pass 2, you still can make adjustments to your schedule during Open Hours, which are from 10:00am-6:00pm on weekends and 6:00am-midnight on weekdays, beginning **November 29th** and going through **December 14th, 2014.**

Fall Graduates: Laboratory Assistant Position at VDX Veterinary Diagnostics

- Lab Assistants work closely with pathologists and other staff to ensure accurate assessment and reporting of pathologic findings. Primary responsibilities include all tasks related to the handling of clinical and research samples, from receipt at the laboratory to the reporting of pathologic findings and archiving of the sample materials. This includes tissue dissection and cytology, inventory and maintenance of laboratory supplies, chemical handling for sample preparations, and disposal of waste.
- Applicants with background experience in laboratory, veterinary, or medical settings and customer service positions are preferred. Experience with and/or course work in biological science, medical/biological terminology, anatomy, and physiology is highly desired. Must have fine motor skills for manipulating specimens and be familiar with Windows, Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook, and other general office equipment.
- The available position is full time. Work hours may vary between 4:00 am and 5:30 pm Monday through Saturday, depending on workload. Coverage of holidays may be required. Hourly wage begins at \$16.00 per hour.
