## Why study abroad?

It is a once in a lifetime opportunity to explore the world while taking classes with your friends, and experiencing new cultures and people.

## Summer Abroad vs. Quarter(s) Abroad

For quarter abroad, UCEAP will be the program to apply through. For summer abroad, UCEAP and UCD Summer Abroad Programs are both available.

Australia, China, England, Ireland, Netherlands, New Zealand, Scotland, Ghana, South African, Korea...

## UC Davis Summer Abroad locations available:

Thailand, Japan, France, England, Austria, Sweden...

## How do I study abroad?

First, start with where you are interested in going. Do you want to see the historical architecture of Europe? Or the beautiful forestry of South America? There are dozens of locations that you can select for a study abroad, so first getting an idea of which continent you are most interested in is critical!

**Both Major & GE courses can be done abroad**



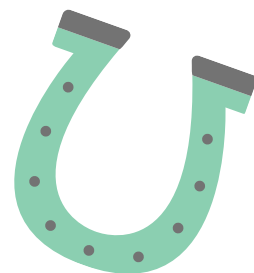

## When do I apply?

For the majority of programs, you'll apply anywhere from 8 months to a year before going!

## What do I need to travel?

- Passport
- Correct Currency/ Credit Cards
- Medication & Vaccines
- Secondary ID (Drivers License)
- Consider travel insurance
