What is VMCAS?

- **Centralized Application process for applications for most of the US veterinary medical colleges**
- Application requires GRE score and transcripts
- VMCAS Applications due **September 17th at 12:00 Midnight**
- VMCAS **STRONGLY** recommends you submit your application and have all transcripts and references received by **September 2, 2018**



 2016-2017





Figures for tuition, fees, cost of attendance/living, and average annual increase in tuition are derived and calculated from AAVMC internal data reports with data collected from 2011-2016. Users should anticipate continued escalations in the cost of education.

Estimated loan interest includes the cost of fully financing a DVM education based on the average graduating loan debt of 2015 graduates borrowing at a rate of 6%.

Data on the amount of average institutional scholarship aid awarded to students is derived from an AAVMC survey of its member institutions on net tuition conducted in 2015. Institutional aid is understood to be college funded scholarship, fellowship, or grant aid awarded to students.

Residency tuition discount does not include special circumstances such as non-resident contract positions or tuition remissions where a portion of non-resident tuition may be refunded upon post-graduation employment within the state.

International Schools Application Process

- VMCAS allows students to apply to international school 19 AVMA accredited schools, as well as 4 AAVMC Affiliate Members.
- Through UCAS students can apply for up to 3 accredited veterinary schools for £25
 - However it's not recommended because it can be rather confusing as it is really set up for UK students
 - You can apply to graduate programs as well

Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS)

- Apply through UCAS for veterinary schools in the UK
- Deadline for UCAS: **October 15th**
- Requires personal statement and reference letters
- Much cheaper alternative for students who are applying
- Can apply to both VMCAS and UCAS

Tuition Costs for International Vet Schools

- **University of Glasgow (No Physics required!)**
 - Cost of Attendance International Fee: £26,750 / \$29,905 a year for 5 years
- **Royal Veterinary College**
 - Cost of Attendance for International Students: £33,000 / \$36,892 a year
 - Average Expenditure for London: £13,388–20,900 / \$14,967–23,365
- **University of Edinburgh, Royal (Dick) School of Veterinary Studies**
 - Cost of Attendance for International Students: £30,200 / \$33,762 a year
- **University of Sydney (No Physics required!)**
 - Cost of Attendance for International Students: \$38,500 a year
- **Cost of Attendance UC Davis Veterinary School: \$31,655**
- **Exchange Rate for US Dollar: 5/30/2017**
 - \$1.12 US Dollar = €1.00 Euro
 - \$1.28 US Dollar = £1.00 British Pound

University of Sydney

- **11th in the World Rankings**
- **Accredited by RCVS**
 - Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (RCVS)
 - Must have 12 weeks of Animal Husbandry Extramural Studies (AHEMS) and 26 weeks of Clinical EMS
- **No interviews**
- **Begins in early February**
- **Minimum GPA of 2.80**
- **Prerequisites**
 - O'chem (CHE 8 A/B)
 - Biology
 - Biochemistry
 - **NO PHYSICS!**



Royal Veterinary School

- 3rd in the World Rankings
- Accredited by RCVS (similar to University of Sydney)
- Interview with family and friends in San Francisco
- Prerequisites
 - CHE 8 A/B
 - PHY 7 A/B/C



Royal Dick Veterinary School (Edinburgh)

- **23rd in the World Rankings**
- **Prerequisites:**
 - **Biology/Zoology**
 - **Physics (PHY 7 A/B)**
 - **Biochemistry**
 - **O'chem and Inorganic chemistry (CHE 8 A/B)**
 - **Mathematics/Statistics**
 - **Genetics**
 - **Microbiology**
 - **Cell Biology**

Looking to Improve Your Chances of Getting into Veterinary School?

1. Apply to Overseas Schools

- Apply to international veterinary schools (i.e. Ross University, St. Georges, and St. Mathews)
- U of Sydney, Royal Veterinary College, U of Edinburgh

2. UC Davis Open Campus

- Open to public
- Provides access to UC Davis upper division science courses to raise overall and science GPA

3. Pursuing a Master's Degree

4. Attend Community College

5. Attend Post Baccalaureate Programs

- Help student transition from undergraduate to professional schools after they have completed their degree
- Raise GPA to be more competitive



Last minute strategies...

- **Take lower division, science courses Summer I**
 - AST, GEL, PLS, SAS
- **Let someone review your answers to narrative prompts**
- **Practice the MMI and traditional interviews!**
 - Historic traditional interview questions can be found on Student Doctor Network
- **Summer veterinary experiences**
- **Letters of Recommendation**

Graduate Record Examination (GRE)

- Only standardized examination required for entrance to all but one US Veterinary School
- Only General Test is Required
 - 3 sections – GRE Quantitative Reasoning
- Seven 30-minute tests (3.5 hours of testing)
- Scores are valid for up to five years after completion
- Must be taken no later than September 1st of the year you apply to veterinary school
 - DO NOT WAIT UNTIL AUGUST TO TAKE IT
 - August would be good for a second time!
- Take this seriously – do not go into it cold
- Cost of the test - \$205, there are fee waivers available

VMCAS Personal Statement

- **VMCAS has changed the personal statement for the upcoming Fall 2018 cycle (1000 Characters)**
- **Be unique!**
- **Prompts are as follows:**
 - There are many career choices within the veterinary profession. What are your future career goals and why?
 - In what ways do veterinarians contribute to society and what do you hope to contribute?
 - Considering the breadth of society we serve as veterinarians today; what attributes do you believe are essential to be successful within the veterinary profession? Of these attributes, which do you possess and how have you demonstrated these in the past?
- **Grammar**
- **No negative comments!**
- **Keep in mind your audience**
- **Proof read – have a friend read (or even us)**
- **UC Davis will include additional “Diversity Statement”**



Great Examples- “Career Question”

“As an aspiring veterinarian, my future career goal is to enhance food production systems and combat other sustainability challenges that affect both human and animal health.....

To supplement this career path, I would like to become board certified in epidemiology and work on research regarding preventative measures that limit disease transmission”

NOT: “I have loved animals since I was born....”

OR: “ I want to work with animals, I don’t like people much.....”

OR: “ I will graduate from vet school and open my own, low-cost clinic”



Great Examples:

“In what way do veterinarians contribute...?”

“The veterinary field is very diverse; earning a veterinary degree does not mean a person needs to pursue general practice. Veterinarians can be responsible for advocating for animal welfare, protecting human and environmental health, and educating the general public”

NOT: “Veterinarians work hard to save all the animals!”

VMCAS Letter of Recommendations

- **Three electronic letter of recommendations are required**
 - One has to be from a veterinarian
 - Check your schools in advance!
 - You may need one from an advisor, professor, etc.
 - There may even be ranking
- **Letters pulled in order received**
 - Multiple letters may actually hurt you rather than help you
- **Narrative letters *not currently read!* (by UC Davis)**
- **Evaluation by Recommenders**



The MMI

- **Multiple Mini Interviews**
- **Short questions**
 - Can be prompts, puzzles, scenarios, etc.
- **Several veterinary schools use the MMI (UCD included)**
- **Practice but don't practice too much!**
- **Several resources are available:**
 - Us
 - Health Professions Advising
 - Workshops
 - Friends
- **Example: You have just accidentally run over your neighbor's cat while reversing your car. You have 5 minutes to break the bad news to her.**



Other Tips

- Enter course names EXACTLY as they appear on official transcript
- Your Primary School is UC Davis
- Enter GE courses as science if they will help




